

Performance Contract

It is expected that all archers involved in the Junior Archery Program run by the Central Alberta Archers Associations (CAAA), be responsible for their behavior. It is our belief that cooperation and communication among all parties will lead to the best results and understanding. We encourage you to review this contract with your children so that they have a clear understanding of our expectations.

Archers shall conduct themselves so as to reasonably comply with the following code of conduct:

1. be diligent in pursuing the sport of archery
2. attend the archery lessons regularly and punctually
3. cooperate with everyone authorized by the Central Alberta Archers Association to provide the archery programs and other activities.
4. comply with the rules of the Red Deer Archery Centre
5. account to the coaches for conduct
6. respect the rights of others

If problem behaviors occur, the following strategies will be employed;

1. the archer will be actively involved in discussion of the incident and clearly aware of the nature of misconduct and follow-up consequences. If necessary, other students will be interviewed to obtain accurate information regarding the misconduct.
2. consequences will be described to the archer and arrangements made to implement the consequences.

At the discretion of the coaches and the executive of the Central Alberta Archers Association, the consequences may include:

1. sitting out for the duration of the lesson
2. suspension for an agreed number of lessons
3. suspension for the rest of the session

Parents: due to safety issues, **DO NOT drop kids off in the parking lot and drive away—please come in with your archers and ensure there is a class that evening before you leave to run errands, etc.** Please ensure you return a minimum of 10 minutes prior to the end of their class to pickup your archer. CAAA is not culpable for children left when there are no classes.

By signing this contract you have read and discussed this contract with your child and you are both aware of the consequences their actions may have.
